Many of you will be self-isolating, dependent on family and friends getting shopping and medical items for you and facing many hours alone.

We are already missing the many things we have may have just taken for granted, including attending Sunday worship, the other activities connected with our church and the warm fellowship and friendship we find there. *Please note, all our Sunday services and activities have now all been suspended until further notice.* 

At times like these it is even more important than ever that we cling onto the promises we find in God's precious Word and to spend much time with Him in prayer. But as well encouraging each of us to depend on the love, grace and mercy that only comes from our great God and wonderful Saviour, we also want to assure you of our practical love and support. We are here to help as best we can.

If you are alone and especially if you don't have family and neighbours to get essentials for you, we would love to help. Maybe you would appreciate it if someone would give you a telephone call to check that you are okay or just to hear a friendly voice, we would be happy to organise that too. Do you need us to connect with you by phone, text or email to reassure you of God's love for you or to offer any other pastoral care and advice? We are here to serve you in Christ's name. At the end of this letter you will see the contact numbers for your minister, Rev. Smyth and your Clerk of Session, Ian Montgomery as your first points of contact. We want to reach out to you. We may not be able to go and visit you in your homes, at your hospital bedside or in your residential and care homes, but we are at the other end of a phone or email message. We still want to show you Christ's love.

- WHATSAPP GROUP: We have an informal WhatsApp group running. This group allows a method for members to encourage one another and share prayer points etc. If you are not already in this group and would like to be, please let Ian know and he can direct you to someone who can help. Also, if you are in this

group, but notifications on your handset are too frequent, let us know and we can talk you through muting those.

- WEEKLY PRAYER MEETINGS: At time of writing, we are accessing a method to allow for <u>"Online Prayer</u> Meetings". If you would like to join us in online prayer, most likely through the Zoom Application, please contact Rev. Smyth and he will put you in contact with somebody who can help.

We would like to finish by leaving with you some words of comfort and reassurance from the Bible.

## Matthew Ch. 6 vs 25-34( ESV) - Do Not Be Anxious

" Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow or reap nor gather into barns, and your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his life span? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?

Therefore do not be anxious, saying, "What shall we eat?" or "What shall we drink?" or "What shall we wear?" For the Gentiles seek after these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteous, and all these things will be added to you.

Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble."
